- There are many opportunities for Matagorda County 4-H'ers to get needed approved Community Service hours in our County. Please see the attached form for several ways to serve in our community in April. Remember... if you sold your raffle ticket and do TWO hours of approved community service work, and turn in the attached form you are eligible to have all of your District and State Fees reimbursed at the end of the summer. This includes entry fees and camp fees!!!
- Major Show Validation Orders are due by 5 p.m. on April 5, after that the price of the tags will go up. This order is for all steers ALL Major Shows, heifers to be validated to go to the Fall Shows, and Lambs and Goats for the Fall Shows.

- Texas 4-H Horse Validations are due by April 15 through 4-H Online. If you want to participate at the District or State Horse Show you must validate your horse. Please call Denise if you have questions.
- It is time to start those 4-H Record Books!!!! All record books will be due May 30. When you complete a record book you are then eligible for the Level of Awards recognition gift cards. If you have any questions please contact Denise or Cynthia and we will be glad to help you.
